
Mimi the Artist's Snowflake Lesson


- 1. Start with a SQUARE piece of paper
- 2. Fold the paper in half, diagonally (into a triangle shape)
- 3. Fold the triangle shape in half to make a smaller triangle
- 4. Fold the small triangle into ANOTHER smaller triangle.
- 5. Time to CUTI

There are 2 sides of the triangle that have some FOLDED edges, you need to be very careful to NOT cut all of the folds out, make sure some of the folds remain because they are needed to hold the snowflake together!


One side has no folded edges so you can cut that side any way you wish!




There are NO folds on this edge



Cut on the edge with NO folds (Example has dotted lines to show where to cut)



Cut into the other 2 sides but be very careful to leave some of the folded paper uncut!
